Romans 12:2

Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

Colossians 3:2 ESV

Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

Philippians 2:5 NIV

Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus.

1 Peter 1:13 ESV

Therefore, with minds that are alert and fully sober, set your hope on the grace to be brought to you when Jesus Christ is revealed at his coming.

Philippians 4:8 NIV

And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise.

2 Corinthians 10:3-6

For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh, for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. *We are* destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and *we are* taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ, and we are ready to punish all disobedience, whenever your obedience is complete.

Romans 7:23

For in my inner being I delight in God's law; but

I see another law at work in me, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within me.

Proverbs 17:22

A cheerful heart is excellent medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones.

Luke 21:34

"Be careful, or your hearts will be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness and the anxieties of life, and that day will close on you suddenly like a trap.

Matthew 22:37

Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind."

Romans 8:7

The mind governed by the flesh is hostile to God; it does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so.

Isaiah 40:13

Who has directed the Spirit of the Lord, Or as His counselor has informed Him?

Corinthians 2:11

For who among men knows the thoughts of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so the thoughts of God no one knows except the Spirit of God.

Philippians 2:5

Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus.

Romans 1:28

And just as they did not see fit to acknowledge God any longer, God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not proper.

Luke 24:45

Then He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures.

Romans 8:5

For those who are according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who are according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit.

Romans 8:7

because the mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God; for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able to do so.

1 Corinthians 2:11

For to us God revealed them through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God.

Romans 11:34

For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who became His counselor?

Romans 12:16

Be of the same mind toward one another; do not be haughty in mind, but associate with the lowly. Do not be wise in your own estimation.

Daniel 4:16

Let his mind be changed from that of a man And let a beast's mind be given to him, And let seven periods of time pass over him.

Romans 7:23

But I see a different law in the members of my body, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin which is in my members.

Proverbs 19:21

Many plans are in a man's heart, But the counsel of the Lord will stand.

Romans 15:6

so that with one accord you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Job 38:36

Who has put wisdom in the innermost being Or given understanding to the mind?

Isaiah 26:3

The steadfast of mind You will keep in perfect peace, Because he trusts in You.

Isaiah 55:8

"For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," declares the Lord.

Jeremiah 17:10

"I, the Lord, search the heart,

I test the mind,

Even to give to each man according to his ways,

According to the results of his deeds.

Ezekiel 38:10

Thus says the Lord God, "It will come about on that day, that thoughts will come into your mind and you will devise an evil plan."

Proverbs 27:19

As in water face reflects face, So the heart of man reflects man.

Proverbs 16:1

The plans of the heart belong to man, But the answer of the tongue is from the Lord.

2 Timothy 1:7

For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline.

Matthew 9:4

And Jesus knowing their thoughts said, "Why are you thinking evil in your hearts?"

James 1:8

Being a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

1 Corinthians 2:14

But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised.

1 Corinthians 14:15

What is the outcome then? I will pray with the spirit and I will pray with the mind also; I will sing with the spirit and I will sing with the mind also.

Ephesians 4:18

Being darkened in their understanding, excluded from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the hardness of their heart.

Romans 7:25

Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, on the one hand I myself with my mind am serving the law of God, but on the other, with my flesh the law of sin.

Genesis 6:5

Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

2 Corinthians 3:14

But their minds were hardened; for until this very day at the reading of the old covenant the same veil remains unlifted, because it is removed in Christ.

Proverbs 16:9

The mind of man plans his way, But the Lord directs his steps.

Isaiah 55:9

"For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways. And My thoughts than your thoughts.

Proverbs 15:26

Evil plans are an abomination to the Lord, But pleasant words are pure.

Ecclesiastes 8

And I saw every work of God, I concluded that man cannot discover the work which has been done under the sun. Even though man should seek laboriously, he will not discover; and though the wise man should say, "I know," he cannot discover.

Psalm 26:2
